Who is at High Risk for Cancer?

Patients with any of following:

- A cancer diagnosis at a young age
- Family history of cancer occurring over multiple generations
- Known hereditary gene mutation
- Personal or family history of multiple colon polyps or inflammatory bowel disease
- A breast biopsy revealing abnormal precancerous cells (Atypical Hyperplasia or Lobular Carcinoma In-Situ)

Cancer Prevention Programs

We offer comprehensive programs with a personalized approach to each patient. Our programs include:

- Cancer risk assessment
- Personalized cancer screening
- Genetic counseling and testing
- Education about lifestyle modification
- Education about the use of preventive drugs aimed at cancer risk reduction
- Nutrition education
- Education about clinical trials in cancer prevention

High Risk Clinic

This clinic is specifically designed to evaluate and care for patients who are at high risk for developing cancer due to a strong family history of cancer or other factors contributing to risk.

Hereditary Cancer Clinic

We care for patients and their families with genetic mutations linked to hereditary cancers. This clinic is suited for patients diagnosed with Hereditary Breast and Ovarian Cancer Syndrome, Hereditary Non-Polyposis Colorectal Cancer Syndrome (Lynch Syndrome), Cowden Syndrome and other hereditary cancer syndromes.
